Senior Warden's Corner

Last Saturday St. Brendan's Vestry held its annual retreat in the church social hall. In truth, it wasn't much of a retreat, but a lengthy work session between 9 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. Years ago our priest and nine-member vestry would go on a real retreat — two overnights at a religious center in Jennerstown, Pa., or Wheeling, W.Va., where they would meditate, pray, take walks in the woods, share meals and make plans for the church year ahead. Rising costs and busy personal schedules put an end to that, and now the vestry devotes five or six hours on a Saturday to the first meeting of the new vestry term.

It's still a meaningful gathering, but there's a lot to pack in. This time, after an opening prayer and remarks by Mother Robin, we elected the vestry clerk (Melanie Popovich) and the parish treasurer (Kevin Boyd), as required each year by parish bylaws. Then we spent an hour going around the table to tell our individual stories, including how we each arrived at St. Brendan's. With the day's agenda timed out, there's no room for team-building games or tests on personality types.

New members were taught (and returning members reviewed) how to read the parish's monthly financial reports. Afterwards we took part in our first give-and-take as a new team: sorting out who will oversee key areas of parish life: Worship, Finance, Children & Youth, Adult Formation, Pastoral Care, Membership, Hospitality, Technology, Outreach and Inreach. (Who got what can be found where vestry members are listed in the weekly Navigator's Log.) If you have a question, concern or suggestion regarding any specific area, please contact the particular vestry member who has oversight — or me.

We worked through lunch and the coffee continued to flow. So did the conversation. We amended St. Brendan's Statement of Affirmation and Inclusion, which appears on the website, to add immigrants and non-citizens. We discussed the need for a funeral luncheon/reception committee. We considered purchase of an Owl video conference camera that would improve group meetings held over Zoom (for vestry, Justice Ministry and other ministries); we put off a decision till March.

Tim Austin, who will chair St. Brendan's Discernment Committee, was our guest for the final hour. Since Mother Robin will be retiring at the end of April, the committee must be assembled and, after her departure, begin the search for St. Brendan's next priest. Tim reviewed a prospective timeline for choosing the committee, surveying parishioners on what they want in their next priest and releasing information about St. Brendan's to prospective candidates.

Call Saturday's meeting a retreat or not, there will be no retreat for the vestry from the work ahead. This is a group that needs your prayers, deserves your support and works for you. God bless them and God bless St. Brendan's.
