Senior Warden's Corner

Last Sunday, at the 10 o'clock service, more than a dozen young Brendanites were recognized for their participation in St. Brendan's Sunday School. They received personalized certificates, special keychains and big slices of cake later in the social hall. It was a thrill for the kids, but what they took home won't compare to all they'll take with them as growing young Christians. The commitment that they — and their parents — make to the program gives the children a foundation in religious faith, a sensitivity to human need and the support of a loving church family.

This essential ministry, which also strengthens the future of our parish, doesn't fall from the sky. Like much of the good done at St. Brendan's, it exists because of the time, energy and devotion of volunteers. Those smiling children, showing off their certificates on the altar, will need a few more teachers to keep their Sunday School rich and robust in the next school year. Fortunately, people at St. Brendan's have a way of stepping up.

On a Monday night in April, nine Brendanites gathered in the social hall to learn how to deliver CPR and use the AED unit that's in the church hallway near the restrooms. They gave of their time to become emergency responders in case a parishioner (or a friend, relative or stranger) were to have a heart attack and needed emergency intervention. It was classic St. Brendan's: answering the call to fill a critical need.

Three weeks later a handful of parishioners assembled to receive training as security stewards. These are the people who keep our church safe on Sunday mornings from potential disruption and intrusion. We lost a few stewards in the past year, but this new infusion will bolster the rotation and lighten the load for those who serve us in this key ministry.

In the same way, our Sunday School is a ministry critical to everyone because it gives St. Brendan's a stake in the future and nurtures the next generation of thinking, acting, progressive Christians. But the several teachers involved in the program are not enough to serve two classes of children, September through May. The spirit of St. Brendan's says we can do better.

It says we need the life-saving skills to save someone during a sudden health crisis. It says we need a secure building perimeter so we can worship peacefully on Sunday mornings. And it says we need an adequate supply of teachers to give our children a Christian education steeped in the Brendanite values of respect, inclusivity and service. The only way to have all these wonderful benefits is to come forward and do our part. Just like those who taught us about God all those years ago.


