Shortly after my ordination in 2021, I wrote an article for the Little Log that discussed the role of a deacon in the Episcopal Church, as defined in the Prayer Book's ordination service and catechism and the canons of the church. The first of those duties is to "represent Christ and his Church, especially as a servant to those in need" (BCP p. 856). So what am I doing these days in fulfillment of this responsibility? The primary means by which I fulfill this servant role is through my ministry to the Sunrise of McCandless assisted living facility on Lincoln Club Road in the North Hills (near Passavant Hospital). Firstly, on the second and fourth Sunday each month I lead an ecumenical worship service with homily and communion 10:30 am. This is a ministry that began in January 2017 but ended in March 2020 due to pandemic restrictions. I resumed this ministry in May of this year. Attendance is typically 10-20. Secondly, in addition to these worship services, every Wednesday I make pastoral visits to residents in the Sunrise facility. Pastoral visits vary in length, depending on the resident and their needs. Sometimes I just sit and listen; sometimes we pray or read Scripture. I do not offer counseling as I'm neither trained nor certified as a counselor. I simply try to be a spiritually healing presence to them to offer comfort and reassurance. My goal is to be a reflection of Christ's redemptive love to those who often do not experience that love in their day to day lives. Apart from the Sunrise pastoral visits, I also make occasional visits to some of St. Brendan's parishioners. We will be expanding these visits in the near future through a small group of volunteers who have expressed a desire to be engaged in this ministry of 'holy presence'.
