Senior Warden's Corner

Sometimes the blessings of St. Brendan's seem too numerous to count. Some are public and out in the open, and thrill many of us all at the same time — like the choir's applause-drawing rendition of "The Rainbow Connection" (from The Muppet Movie) last Sunday. Some are private and person-to-person, like the care and concern shown by one member to another who's facing a personal crisis. Each is a moment of grace, large or small, and Brendanites often encounter them when they least expect it.

A different kind of blessing, one that supports the church's physical needs, is the Brendan's Friends and Family fund, or BFF. As you've read many times in the Navigator's Log, BFF offers anyone the opportunity in our newsletter to mark a special occasion like a birth, anniversary or birthday or to honor someone living or dead by making a contribution to the church of any amount. The size of the gift is not publicized, but the brief tribute by the donor is.

Created by the vestry in 2018 after it was proposed by member Chris Botti, BFF has been used to cover unbudgeted church expenses. Since its creation in 2018, BFF has been used by the vestry to cover unbudgeted church expenses. To give current vestry members a sense of all that the fund has provided, I asked the parish treasurer for the total list of BFF purchases and sent it to the vestry prior to Monday's meeting. One reaction was that the complete list should be shared with the congregation, perhaps in the parish's next annual report. But that report won't appear until next January, so I decided to share the list now, which you'll see below.

You'll find a formidable assortment of goods that have improved St. Brendan's and even given it new capabilities. For instance, live-streaming the 10 am Sunday service was made possible by equipment bought through your gifts to the BFF fund. The social hall's mounted projector, retractable screen and sound-proofing tiles came courtesy of BFF. More mundane, yet necessary, items were purchased, too — a furnace, air-conditioning units, fresh paint for the exterior stucco walls. Then there was new tableware for the kitchen, a children's swing set, a heart-starting defibrillator — items that may not have found their way into a tight operating budget, but were funded by BFF, courtesy of your generosity. In six years, BFF has generated \$58,105 of benefits to the church, plus a BFF balance today of \$19,358 to cover future needs.

At St. Brendan's the blessings come in many forms — in poignant moments on Sunday morning, in personal support and friendship, in chances to learn and grow, in opportunities to do good and, yes, in gracious tributes through BFF that make ours a more welcoming, better functioning church.
