The 8:00 Eucharist will be in the chapel as usual.

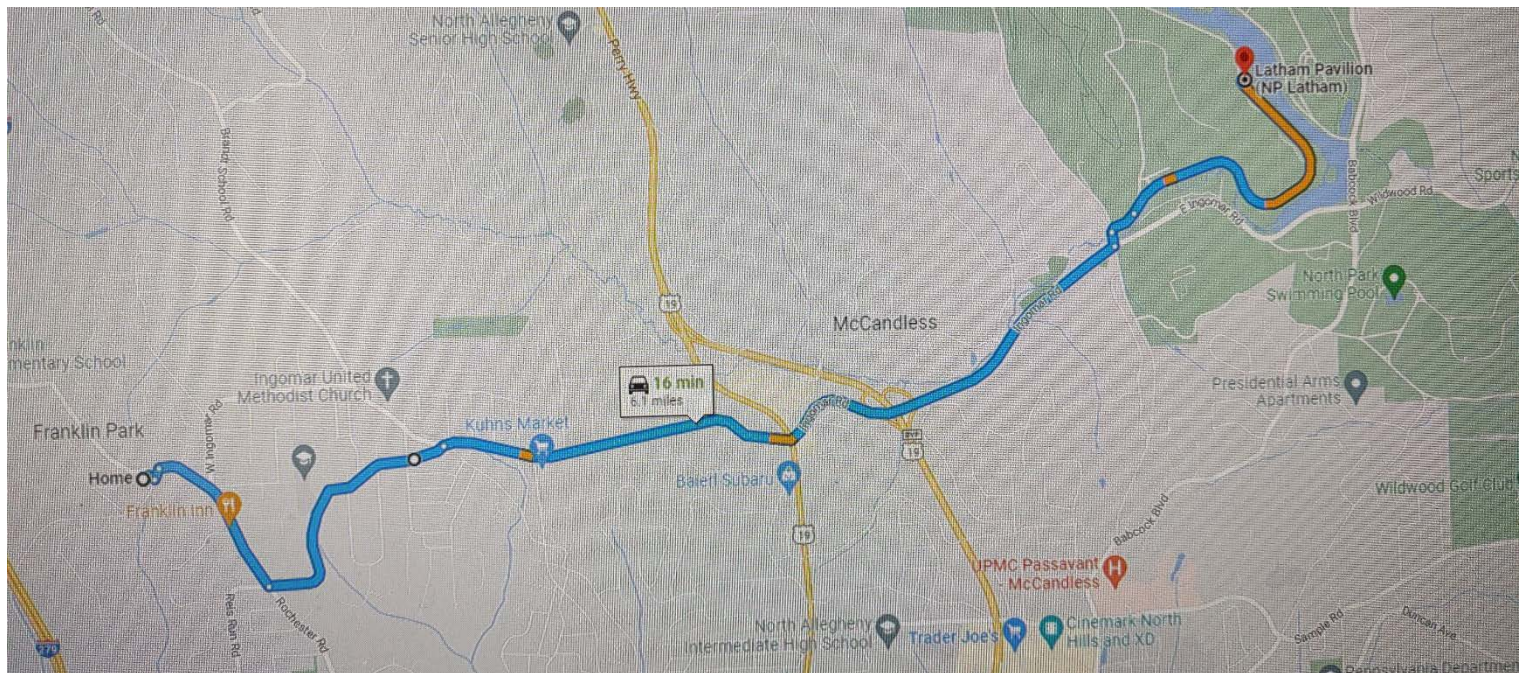
The 10:00 Eucharist will be held at Latham Shelter in the park followed by the picnic.
